## Data Processing Context - Behavioural Data

Telephone call history from an ISP that includes recent call history
Telephone call history from a mental wellbeing call centre
Data from supermarket card recording items brought

## Data Processing Context - Financial Data

Credit card information over 10 years old
Credit card information copied when online shopping

## Circumstances of the Breach - Confidentiality

An employee sells a CD ROM with customer data.
Email (personal data) wrongly sent to a number of known recipients. $\qquad$

## Circumstances of the Breach - Integrity

Personal data in a database wrongly updated (not backed up)

## Ease of Identification

A Database of passport information is lost
A pseudonymised table with unique id, gender, height, weight and postcode is lost
