ALTERATION OF ARTICLES – COMPANY CHECKLIST

- 1. Draft exact wording of proposed change (consult advocate if necessary).
- 2. Send out notice of board meeting.
- 3. Hold board meeting and agree the change.
- 4. Minute the board meeting.
- 5. Authorise the secretary to convene and EGM or put on the agenda for the next AGM.
- 6. Send out notice to shareholders (special notice unless short notice allowed).
- 7. Hold shareholders meeting and pass special resolution to change the Articles.
- 8. Minute the Shareholders meeting.
- 9. File a copy of the special resolution with Guernsey Registry.
- 10. Arrange for the Articles to be amended.
- 11. Send amended copy of Articles (and / or copy of special resolution to those people entitled to them.
